Talbot County - Turkey and Deer Hunting - Sundays

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a person to hunt turkey on a Sunday in Talbot County through participation in a certain junior hunt; authorizing the Department to allow a person to hunt deer on a Sunday in Talbot County with a firearm through participation in a certain junior deer hunt or during any Sunday during the winter portion of a certain deer firearms season in a certain region; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to turkey and deer hunting in Talbot County on a Sunday.

Is at least 21 years of age; 16 Possesses a valid hunting license or is exempt from B. 17 hunting license requirements; and C. 18 Is not in possession of a firearm, a bow, or any other hunting device. 19 20 A person who participates in the junior deer hunt may use a 21 firearm to hunt deer on the days of the hunt. 22 10-410.23 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays. 24 THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY IN TALBOT COUNTY. 25 (15) (I)26 THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A PERSON TO HUNT TURKEY (II)27 ON A SUNDAY THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN THE JUNIOR HUNT FOR TURKEYS, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT. 28
- 29 (III) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A PERSON TO HUNT DEER 30 WITH A FIREARM ON A SUNDAY:

- 1. Through participation in the Junior deer 2 hunt established under § 10–405(a) of this subtitle; and
- 2. During any Sunday during the winter portion of the deer firearms season in the deer management region of which Talbot County is a part, as designated by the Department.
