1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Environment – Organics Recycling and Composting – Grant Program

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment, in consultation with the
  Maryland Environmental Service, to establish a grant program to assist counties
  with certain costs associated with the collection, recycling, and composting of
  organics and other compostable materials from residential properties; requiring the
  Service to implement and administer the grant program in a certain manner;
  specifying sources of funding for the grant program; defining a certain term; and

3 (1) ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES FOR GRANT 4 APPLICATIONS THAT INCLUDE PROVISIONS ENCOURAGING COUNTIES TO SHARE 5 RESOURCES;

6 (2) DEVELOPING A PROCESS FOR REVIEWING GRANT APPLICATIONS 7 AND AWARDING GRANTS TO COUNTIES FOR ELIGIBLE PROJECTS; AND

14(3) ANY ADDITIONAL MONEY MADE AVAILABLE TO THE GRANT15PROGRAM FROM ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SOURCE.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2020.
