A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation to require operators of cruise vessels or cruise lines to reimburse passengers for cancellation due to COVID-19, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REIMBURSEMENT FOR CANCELLATION OF
- 4 CRUISES.
- 5 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Transportation
- 6 shall issue such regulations as are necessary to ensure that
- 7 operators of cruise vessels or cruise lines are required to
- 8 reimburse an individual for the ticket price of a cruise,

- 1 for which such individual purchased a ticket on or before
- 2 February 1, 2020, in the event that—
- 3 (1) such cruise is canceled due to COVID-19;
- 4 or
- 5 (2) such individual cancels such cruise due to
- 6 concern over COVID-19.
- 7 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply for
- 8 the duration of any emergency declared with respect to
- 9 COVID-19.
