### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Leak and Lose Act5 of 2023".

# 1SEC. 2. CONCEALMENT, REMOVAL, OR MUTILATION OF SU-2PREME COURT OPINION OR DRAFT OPINION.

3 Section 2071 of title 18, United States Code, is 4 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-5 section:

"(c) Whoever willfully and unlawfully conceals, re-6 7 moves, mutilates, obliterates, or destroys, or attempts to 8 do so, or, with intent to do so takes and carries away (in-9 cluding electronically) from a building in which the Supreme Court conducts business, any opinion or draft opin-10 ion of a case being heard by the Supreme Court, prior 11 to the date on which such opinion is published by the Su-12 13 preme Court, shall be fined \$5000, and if applicable, shall 14 forfeit their admission to all Federal courts and shall be ineligible for admission to a Federal court for the remain-15 16 der of their life.".
