11	WHEREAS, before Reconstruction, a largely African
12	American population in Macon County was not able to vote for a
13	sheriff; and
14	WHEREAS, Lucius D. Amerson was an Army veteran who
15	became sheriff of Macon County, Alabama, in the late 1960's
16	following the passage of the Voting Rights Act; and
17	WHEREAS, Sheriff Amerson was the first African
18	American sheriff elected in the deep South after
19	Reconstruction; and
20	WHEREAS, many saw his election as a sign of progress
21	for Black Americans in Alabama fighting for equality and
22	against police brutality; and
23	WHEREAS, Sheriff Amerson's story represents a
24	defining moment in law enforcement history; today, police
25	departments nationwide acknowledge that recruiting and
26	maintaining a diverse force remains a challenge; Alabamians
27	such as Sheriff Amerson serves as a constant reminder that

establishing trust between law enforcement and the public is a critical component of ensuring public safety in this state for future generations; and

WHEREAS, the National Law Enforcement Museum in Washington, D.C., will highlight the historic life of Sheriff Amerson as a shining example of the vital role diversity plays in keeping our great communities safe; and

WHEREAS, it is befitting that this state pays tribute to Sheriff Amerson for his loyal and courageous service to the residents of Macon County, as well as his impact in breaking racial barriers for the greater good of this state; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in honor of Sheriff Lucius D. Amerson, we declare that U.S. Highway 29 South (SR-15) from mile point 162.582 to 164.609 on U.S. Highway 29 South (SR-15) be named in perpetuity, Lucius D. Amerson Memorial Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Transportation is requested to erect the appropriate signs or markers as provided in this resolution in recognition of this memorial designation.
