Mr. Udall (for himself, Mr. Gardner, Ms. Cortez Masto, and Mr. Whitehouse) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation

A BILL

To require the Federal Communications Commission to make the provision of Wi-Fi access on school buses eligible for E-rate support.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. E-RATE SUPPORT FOR SCHOOL BUS WI-FI.
- 4 (a) Definition.—In this section, the term "school
- 5 bus" means a passenger motor vehicle that is—
- 6 (1) designed to carry a driver and not less than
- 7 5 passengers; and
- 8 (2) used significantly to transport early child
- 9 education, elementary school, or secondary school

- 1 students to or from school or an event related to
- 2 school.
- 3 (b) Rulemaking.—Notwithstanding the limitations
- 4 under paragraphs (1)(B) and (2)(A) of section 254(h) of
- 5 the Communications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 254(h)) re-
- 6 garding the authorized recipients and uses of discounted
- 7 telecommunications services, not later than 180 days after
- 8 the date of enactment of this Act, the Federal Commu-
- 9 nications Commission shall commence a rulemaking to
- 10 make the provision of Wi-Fi access on school buses eligible
- 11 for support under the E-rate program of the Commission
- 12 set forth under subpart F of part 54 of title 47, Code
- 13 of Federal Regulations.
