 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Lower Health Insur-
 - 5 ance Deductibles Act".

1	SEC. 2. HIGH DEDUCTIBLE HEALTH PLAN DEDUCTIBLE
2	AND CATASTROPHIC COVERAGE FLEXIBILITY
3	FOR PURPOSES OF HSAS.
4	(a) In General.—Paragraph (2) of section 223(c)
5	of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by add-
6	ing at the end the following new subparagraph:
7	"(E) Division of annual deduct-
8	IBLE.—A plan shall not fail to be treated as a
9	high deductible health plan by reason of having
10	separate annual deductibles for medicine or
11	drugs and for other medical care if the sum of
12	such deductibles, if treated as 1 annual deduct-
13	ible, meets the requirements of subparagraph
14	(A).".
15	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
16	this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
17	the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
