A BILL

To require the publication of the name of any person pardoned by the President, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Presidential Pardon
- 5 Transparency Act of 2017".

1 SEC. 2. PUBLICATION OF PARDONS.

- 2 Not later than 3 days after the date on which the
- 3 President grants any reprieve or pardon for an offence
- 4 against the United States, the Attorney General shall pub-
- 5 lish in the Federal Register and on the official website
- 6 of the President the following:
- 7 (1) The name of the person.
- 8 (2) The date on which the reprieve or pardon
- 9 was issued.
- 10 (3) The full text of the reprieve or pardon.
