3	(8) A vehicle owned by, or leased to, and personally used by a veteran who:
4 5	(i) As designated or classified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, has lost the use of a hand, arm, or leg, or is totally disabled; or
6	(ii) Has a permanent impairment of both eyes so that:
7 8	1. The central visual acuity is 20/200 or less in the better eye, with corrective glasses; or
9 10 11	2. There is a field defect in which the peripheral field has contracted to such an extent that the widest diameter of visual field subtends an angular distance no greater than 20 degrees in the better eye;
$12 \\ 13 \\ 14$	(9) A vehicle owned and personally used by an individual who is the surviving spouse of a deceased disabled veteran, as defined under § $7-208$ of the Tax – Property Article; [and]

17 18 19	(11) NOT MORE THAN ONE VEHICLE OWNED BY, OR LEASED TO, AND PERSONALLY USED BY A VETERAN WHO IS UNEMPLOYABLE DUE TO A SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY.
