3 To make a supplemental appropriation from the
4 Education Trust Fund to the State Department of Education in
5 the amount of \$14,085,735 for the fiscal year ending September
6 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the
7 Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Community College System
8 in the amount of \$501,943 for the fiscal year ending September
9 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the
10 Education Trust Fund to the Marine Environmental Sciences
11 Consortium in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year
12 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
13 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to Alabama State
14 University in the amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal year
15 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
16 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
17 Department of Commerce in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the
18 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
19 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Fire
20 College in the amount of \$144,000 for the fiscal year ending
21 September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from
22 the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Institute for the Deaf
23 and Blind in the amount of \$6,878,778 for the fiscal year
24 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
25 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the University

1 of South Alabama in the amount of \$500,000 for the fiscal year
2 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
3 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
4 Department of Archives and History in the amount of \$50,000
5 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a
6 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to
7 the Department of Early Childhood Education in the amount of
8 \$2,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to
9 make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
10 Fund to the Alabama Supercomputer Authority in the amount of
11 \$2,500,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to
12 make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
13 Fund to Miles College in the amount of \$35,000 for the fiscal
14 year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
15 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to Stillman
16 College in the amount of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending
17 September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from
18 the Education Trust Fund to Wallace Community Collge-Selma in
19 the amount of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30,
20 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education
21 Trust Fund to Athens State University in the amount of
22 \$280,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to
23 make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
24 Fund to Troy University in the amount of \$175,000 for the
25 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental

1 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
2 Commission on Higher Education in the amount of \$240,000 for
3 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a
4 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to
5 the Education Trust Fund Advancement and Technology Fund in
6 the amount of \$2,170,265 for the fiscal year ending September
7 30, 2020; to amend language in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 for
8 the Alabama State Council on the Arts; to amend language in
9 Section 3B of Act 2019-403 for the Alabama School of Cyber
10 Technology and Engineering; to amend language in Section 3A of
11 Act 2019-403 for the Examiner of Public Accounts; and to
12 revise the repayment dates for certain withdrawals from the
13 Budget Stabilization Fund.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

15 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
16 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
17 \$14,085,735 from the Education Trust Fund to the State
18 Department of Education for the fiscal year ending September
19 30, 2020. Of this appropriation, \$9,835,735 shall be expended
20 for expansion of the science of reading training in support of
21 initial implementations of the Literacy Act; \$2,700,000 shall
22 be expended for additional regional math coaches and trainers
23 to expand early mathematics improvement efforts and AMSTI,
24 NUMBERS, and OGAP training opportunities; \$250,000 shall be
25 expended to be paired with existing resources of the

1 Department to continue the provision of one school safety
2 liaison per ALEA region to assist schools across the state;
3 \$1,000,000 shall be expended for a marketing campaign for
4 teachers; and \$300,000 shall be expended for teacher and
5 parent online teaching assistance grants.

6 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
7 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
8 \$501,943 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
9 Community College System for the fiscal year ending September
10 30, 2020.

11 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
12 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
13 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine
14 Environmental Sciences Consortium for the fiscal year ending
15 September 30, 2020 for Wetlab relocation and renovation.

16 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations
17 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
18 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
19 Department of Commerce for the fiscal year ending September
20 30, 2020 to assist with the expansion of the Lockheed Martin
21 Corporation training facility.

22 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations
23 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
24 \$400,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Alabama State

1 University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
2 one-time repair expenses for the forensics lab.

3 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$144,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Fire
6 College for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
7 one-time expenses for an audio/visual presentation system.

8 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations
9 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
10 \$6,878,778 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
11 Institute for the Deaf and Blind for the fiscal year ending
12 September 30, 2020 to assist in the construction and expansion
13 of regional centers.

14 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations
15 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
16 \$500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the University of
17 South Alabama for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020
18 for one-time expenses for Children and Women's Learning
19 Hospital expansion.

20 Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations
21 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
22 \$2,170,265 from the Education Trust Fund to the Education
23 Trust Fund Advancement and Technology Fund for the fiscal year
24 ending September 30, 2020 to be allocated in accordance with
25 Section 29-9-4, Code of Alabama 1975.

1 Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations
2 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
3 \$50,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
4 Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year ending
5 September 30, 2020.

6 Section 11. In addition to all other appropriations
7 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
8 \$2,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Department of
9 Early Childhood Education for the fiscal year ending September
10 30, 2020.

11 Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations
12 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
13 \$2,500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
14 Supercomputer Authority for the fiscal year ending September
15 30, 2020 for cybersecurity and IT support for K-12 schools in
16 consultation with ALETS, of which \$1,000,000 shall be expended
17 for professional development for all education employees in
18 the form of software-based cybersecurity training focused on
19 improving digital security.

20 Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations
21 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
22 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Miles College for the
23 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020

24 Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations
25 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

1 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Stillman College for
2 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

3 Section 15. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Wallace Community
6 College-Selma for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020
7 for Excellence in Education to Employment Pipeline.

8 Section 16. In addition to all other appropriations
9 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
10 \$280,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Athens State
11 University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
12 virtual lab kits and student virtual interfaces and cloud
13 delivery expenses.

14 Section 17. In addition to all other appropriations
15 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
16 \$175,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Troy University for
17 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for the Sign
18 Language Interpretive Center.

19 Section 18. In addition to all other appropriations
20 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
21 \$240,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
22 Commission on Higher Education for the fiscal year ending
23 September 30, 2020, of which \$120,000 shall be for the City of
24 Decatur and \$120,000 shall be for Marengo County to establish
25 the Best and Brightest STEM Pilot Program for the purpose of

1 paying the student loan debt of recent STEM graduates that
2 relocate to the City of Decatur and Marengo County. Applicants
3 must have a STEM degree from an Alabama four-year institution
4 of higher education and cannot be a resident of the subject
5 county at the time of application. The duration of the pilot
6 program shall be no more than five years and the amount
7 available per graduate shall be \$3,000 annually.

8 Section 19. All funds appropriated in this act not
9 expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 shall
10 not revert but shall be carried forward for the purpose
11 appropriated.

12 Section 20. The appropriation made within the Fine
13 Arts Program of the Alabama State Council on the Arts in
14 Section 3B of Act 2019-403 is amended to read as follows: "Of
15 the above appropriation, \$875,000 shall be expended for the
16 Alabama Center for the Arts, of which \$75,000 shall be
17 expended for Urban Art; \$75,000 shall be expended for the Arts
18 Hall of Fame; and \$200,000 shall be expended for the Alabama
19 Center for the Arts Foundation."

20 Section 21. Notwithstanding any other provision of
21 law to the contrary, any of the appropriation made in Section
22 3B of Act 2019-403 to the Alabama School of Cyber Technology
23 and Engineering which remains unexpended on September 30,
24 2020, shall be reappropriated to the school in the fiscal year
25 beginning October 1, 2020.

1 Section 22. Notwithstanding any other provision of
2 law to the contrary, any funds appropriated in Section 3A of
3 Act 2019-403 to the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts
4 for the evaluation and reorganization study of the State
5 Department of Education which remains unexpended on September
6 30, 2020, shall be reappropriated to the Department in the
7 fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020.

8 Section 23. Notwithstanding the provisions of
9 Sections 29-9-6, Code of Alabama 1975, during the fiscal year
10 ending September 30, 2020, temporary transfers from the Budget
11 Stabilization Fund into the Education Trust Fund to alleviate
12 cash flow problems shall be repaid within 180 days following
13 the date the funds are transferred. Notwithstanding the
14 provisions of Section 29-9-5(b), amounts withdrawn prior to
15 January 1, 2020 shall be repaid within four years.

16 Section 24. This act shall become effective
17 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
18 upon its otherwise becoming law.
