#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Treating Barriers to

5 Prosperity Act of 2018".

#### 6 SEC. 2. DRUG ABUSE MITIGATION INITIATIVE.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 145 of title 40, United

8 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 14509

9 the following:

#### 1 "§ 14510. Drug abuse mitigation initiative

"(a) IN GENERAL.—The Appalachian Regional Commission may provide technical assistance to, make grants
to, enter into contracts with, or otherwise provide amounts
to individuals or entities in the Appalachian region for
projects and activities to address drug abuse, including
opioid abuse, in the region, including projects and activities—

9 "(1) to facilitate the sharing of best practices
10 among States, counties, and other experts in the re11 gion with respect to reducing such abuse;

"(2) to initiate or expand programs designed to
eliminate or reduce the harm to the workforce and
economic growth of the region that results from such
abuse;

16 "(3) to attract and retain relevant health care17 services, businesses, and workers; and

18 "(4) to develop relevant infrastructure, includ19 ing broadband infrastructure that supports the use
20 of telemedicine.

21 "(b) LIMITATION ON AVAILABLE AMOUNTS.—Of the
22 cost of any activity eligible for a grant under this sec23 tion—

24 "(1) not more than 50 percent may be provided
25 from amounts appropriated to carry out this section;

"(2) notwithstanding paragraph (1)—

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2 "(A) in the case of a project to be carried
3 out in a county for which a distressed county
4 designation is in effect under section 14526,
5 not more than 80 percent may be provided from
6 amounts appropriated to carry out this section;
7 and

8 "(B) in the case of a project to be carried 9 out in a county for which an at-risk designation 10 is in effect under section 14526, not more than 11 70 percent may be provided from amounts ap-12 propriated to carry out this section.

"(c) SOURCES OF ASSISTANCE.—Subject to subsection (b), a grant provided under this section may be
provided from amounts made available to carry out this
section in combination with amounts made available—

17 "(1) under any other Federal program (subject
18 to the availability of subsequent appropriations); or
19 "(2) from any other source.

"(d) FEDERAL SHARE.—Notwithstanding any provision of law limiting the Federal share under any other
Federal program, amounts made available to carry out
this section may be used to increase that Federal share,
as the Appalachian Regional Commission determines to be
appropriate.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap ter 145 of title 40, United States Code, is amended by
 inserting after the item relating to section 14509 the fol lowing:

"14510. Drug abuse mitigation initiative.".
