3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Elderly Home Deten-
5 tion Pilot Program Technical Corrections Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. CREDITS FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY NONVIOLENT OF-**
2 **FENDERS.**

3 Section 231(g)(5)(A)(ii) of the Second Chance Act of
4 2007 (34 U.S.C. 60541(g)(5)(A)(ii)) is amended by strik-
5 ing “to which the offender was sentenced” and inserting
6 “reduced by any credit toward the service of the prisoner’s
7 sentence awarded under section 3624(b) of title 18,
8 United States Code”.

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
