# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

#### 1 "An Act relating to election of a permanent presiding officer."

# 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 \* Section 1. AS 24.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 Sec. 24.05.165. Election of a permanent presiding officer. (a) If a house of 5 the legislature has not elected a permanent presiding officer within 14 calendar days 6 after the convening of the first regular session of a legislature, the members of the 7 political party that has a majority of the members elected to that house shall elect a 8 permanent presiding officer.

- 9 (b) Election of a permanent presiding officer requires a majority vote of the 10 members of the political party granted the authority to elect the permanent presiding 11 officer under (a) of this section.
- (c) If no political party has a majority of the membership in a house of the
  legislature, election of a permanent presiding officer requires a majority vote of the
  full membership of the house.
