LONG TITLE**General Description:**

This bill addresses studying diverting Green River water into the Wasatch Front.

ENACTS:

73-10-35, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **73-10-35** is enacted to read:

73-10-35. Division of Water Resources to conduct certain study.

(1) As used in this section:

(a) "2002 Study" means the Green River Pipeline Cost Analysis prepared by the



Division of Water Resources in 2002, including the addendum.

(b) "Division" means the Division of Water Resources.

(2) The division shall:

(a) update the 2002 Study to provide current cost estimates related to the feasibility of diverting Green River water into the Wasatch Front through the Bear River or the Weber River; and

(b) study reasonable alternative methods, if any, of diverting Green River water into the Wasatch Front that are not addressed in the 2002 Study.

(3) The studies required by Subsection (2) shall include an analysis of both diversion through the Bear River and diversion through the Weber River.

(4) (a) The division shall present the study required by Subsection (2)(a) to the Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee by no later than the 2020 November interim meeting of the Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee.

(b) The division shall present the study required by Subsection (2)(b) to the Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee by no later than the 2021 November interim meeting of the Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee.
