3 Section 7(b)(3) of the Endangered Species Act of
4 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1536(b)(3)) is amended by adding at the
5 end the following:

6 "(C) In determining whether a Federal agency action 7 is likely to jeopardize the continued existence of any en-8 dangered species or threatened species or result in the de-9 struction or adverse modification of the critical habitat of a species, the Secretary shall consider the offsetting ef-10 fects of all avoidance, minimization, and other species-pro-11 12 tection or conservation measures that are already in place or proposed to be implemented as part of the action, in-13 14 cluding the development, improvement, protection, or management of species habitat whether or not it is des-15 16 ignated as critical habitat of such species.".
