A BILL

To amend the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act to require notification with respect to individualized education program teams, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Think Differently
5 about Education Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT FOR IEP TEAMS.**

7 Section 614(d) of the Individuals with Disabilities
8 Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1414(d)) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following:

1 “(8) NOTIFICATION REQUIRED.—At the begin-
2 ning of each school year, each local educational
3 agency, State educational agency, or other State
4 agency, as the case may be, shall notify each parent
5 of a child with a disability in the agency’s jurisdic-
6 tion that such parent may, under paragraph
7 (1)(B)(vi), include individuals who have knowledge
8 or special expertise regarding the child, including re-
9 lated services personnel as appropriate, as part of
10 the individualized education program team for such
11 child.”.
