AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 166.7, as amended by Section 839, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 16 2016, Section 166.7), is amended to read as follows: 17 Section 166.7. A. There is hereby created in the State 18 Treasury a revolving fund for the Commission on Rehabilitation 19 Services, to be designated the "Rehabilitation Services Disbursing 20 Fund" provided that the fund may be designated by fiscal year 21 designations as the Commission may determine. The fund shall be a 22 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations. The fund 23 shall consist of receipts from the federal government, monies 24

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appropriated to the State Department of Rehabilitation Services by the State Legislature, and other receipts of the State Department of Rehabilitation Services as shall be directed by the Commission for Rehabilitation Services. All monies accruing to the credit of said the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Commission for Rehabilitation Services as may be necessary in order to carry out the duties imposed upon the said Commission by law. Expenditures from the Rehabilitation Services Disbursing Fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

- B. Appropriations, federal monies or any other monies collected by or for the Department and monies from the current and prior fiscal years may be transferred to and between the agency disbursing funds for the current or prior fiscal years, the Medical and Assistance Funds and any other funds authorized for the use by the Department as necessary to carry out the duties of the Commission.

 All transfer requests shall be in writing to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. Such monies transferred shall be included in the Department's budget work program. The Department shall maintain records of the transfers.
 - C. Receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds awarded to the Department after the commencement of the fiscal year

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    shall be exempt from expenditure limitations, provided that any such
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    funds are included in the Department's budget work program.
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        D. The Director of the Department may request through the
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    Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services the
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    early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collection to
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    the General Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the
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    Department's disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.
        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
