7 a letter of opinion from the Government Accountability  
8 Office dated July 15, 2019, printed in the Congressional  
9 Record on July 17, 2019, on pages S4901–S4903, con-  
10 cluding that such guidance is a rule under the Congres-  
11 sional Review Act), and such rule shall have no force or
