- 2 (A) IF THE BOARD INTENDS TO EXAMINE THE BUSINESS RECORDS OF A 3 LICENSE HOLDER, THE BOARD SHALL:
- 4 (1) GIVE THE LICENSE HOLDER AT LEAST 5 DAYS' NOTICE OF ITS 5 INTENT; AND
- 6 (2) MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH THE LICENSE HOLDER TO CARRY 7 OUT THE EXAMINATION.
- 8 (B) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY KEEP BUSINESS RECORDS:
- 9 (1) IN AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT THAT THE BOARD APPROVES; AND
- 10 (2) AT A LOCATION AWAY FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
