A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Business Records**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of License Commissioners for Harford County to
4 give a license holder a certain notice before the Board may examine the business
5 records of the license holder; requiring the Board to make an appointment with the
6 license holder to carry out the examination; authorizing the license holder to keep
7 business records in a certain manner; and generally relating to business records of
8 an alcoholic beverages license holder in Harford County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

22 22–102.

23 This title applies only in Harford County.

2 **(A) IF THE BOARD INTENDS TO EXAMINE THE BUSINESS RECORDS OF A**
3 **LICENSE HOLDER, THE BOARD SHALL:**

4 **(1) GIVE THE LICENSE HOLDER AT LEAST 5 DAYS' NOTICE OF ITS**
5 **INTENT; AND**

6 **(2) MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH THE LICENSE HOLDER TO CARRY**
7 **OUT THE EXAMINATION.**

8 **(B) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY KEEP BUSINESS RECORDS:**

9 **(1) IN AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT THAT THE BOARD APPROVES; AND**

10 **(2) AT A LOCATION AWAY FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES.**

11 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July**
12 **1, 2020.**
