A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- To amend Article 1 of Chapter 9 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 1
- 2 relating to air quality, so as to provide for the reporting of any unpermitted release of
- 3 ethylene oxide to the Environmental Protection Division; to provide for public notification
- 4 of such releases by the Environmental Protection Division; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 6

7 **SECTION 1.**

- 8 Article 1 of Chapter 9 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to air
- 9 quality, is amended in subsection (a) of Code Section 12-9-7, relating to permit required,
- 10 application, issuance, revocation, suspension, or amendment, as follows:

- 12 (a)(1) No person shall, and it shall be unlawful and a violation of this article to,
- 13 construct, install, modify, own, or operate any facility or stationary source or any
- 14 equipment, device, article, or process capable of causing or contributing to the emission
- 15 of air contaminants from such source or facility or designed to prevent air pollution from
- such facility or source unless permitted by and in compliance with a permit from the 16
- director. A permit shall be issued to an applicant on evidence satisfactory to the director 17
- of compliance with this article and any standards, limitations, requirements, or rules and
- regulations pursuant to this article. Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, 19
- the director shall not issue a Title V permit to a facility or source if the administrator 20
- 21 objects in writing and in a timely manner to the issuance of such permit.
- 22 (2) As a condition of a permit, any unpermitted release of ethylene oxide, regardless of
- the amount, shall be reported to the division via email within 24 hours of discovering 23
- such release. Such information shall be made publicly available on the division's 24
- website. Any person who violates such reporting requirement shall be subject to 25
- penalties under Article 1 of this chapter." 26
