- 4 WHEREAS, Byron Elementary School is the only elementary school to offer a Junior ROTC
- 5 program in the State of Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Boatswain Mate Sheldone Almond, a former service member, serves as the
- 7 Junior ROTC instructor at Byron Elementary School; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Navy Junior ROTC program seeks to instill in students the value of
- 9 citizenship, service to the United States, personal responsibility, and a sense of
- 10 accomplishment; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Byron Elementary School sought to implement a program that would transform
- boys and girls into respectful and responsible young adults by giving them the opportunity

- leadership skills and cultivating their capacity to be successful; and

- twice a week, wear uniforms every Thursday, and raise and lower the American flag daily;
