A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Eric Garner Excessive
- 5 Use of Force Prevention Act of 2019".

1 SEC. 2. CHOKEHOLDS AS CIVIL RIGHTS VIOLATIONS.

- 2 Section 242 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 3 amended by adding at the end the following: "For the pur-
- 4 poses of this section, the application of any pressure to
- 5 the throat or windpipe which may prevent or hinder
- 6 breathing or reduce intake of air is a punishment, pain,
- 7 or penalty.".
