Alcoholic Beverages - Manufacturers - Direct Transfer Permit

1	AN ACT concerning	

- FOR the purpose of establishing a direct transfer alcoholic beverages permit; authorizing a local licensing board to issue the permit to the holder of a manufacturer's license; specifying that the permit authorizes the holder to sell or provide free samples of beer, wine, or liquor for on-premises consumption under certain circumstances; establishing that the sale of certain beer, wine, or liquor may not count toward certain limits on sales; establishing the hours for sale for the permit and an annual permit fee; and generally relating to the direct transfer alcoholic beverages permit.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 **4–1107.**
- 19 (A) THERE IS A DIRECT TRANSFER PERMIT.
- 20 (B) A LOCAL LICENSING BOARD MAY ISSUE THE PERMIT TO THE HOLDER OF 21 A MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE.
- 22 (C) THE PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER, FOR ON-PREMISES 23 CONSUMPTION, TO:



- 1 (1) SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR PRODUCED BY THE PERMIT 2 HOLDER OR ANOTHER HOLDER OF A MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE; AND
- 3 (2) PROVIDE A FREE SAMPLE OF THE BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR THAT IS 4 AUTHORIZED FOR SALE UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 5 (D) EXCEPT FOR BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR THAT IS PRODUCED BY THE 6 PERMIT HOLDER, ANY BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR SOLD BY THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT COUNT TOWARD A LIMIT ESTABLISHED BY THE UNDERLYING MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE ON THE AMOUNT OF BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR THE MANUFACTURER MAY 9 SELL.
- 10 (E) THE HOURS FOR SALE FOR A DIRECT TRANSFER PERMIT ARE THE SAME 11 AS THOSE FOR THE UNDERLYING MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE.
- 12 **(F)** THE ANNUAL PERMIT FEE IS \$250.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
