

1 AN ACT relating to elections.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 117.225 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) Any person desiring to vote on election day shall give his ***or her*** name and address
5 to the ***precinct election*** clerk~~[of the election]~~. If the person's name is listed on the
6 precinct list furnished by the State Board of Elections as provided in KRS 117.025
7 and if no challenge is made, ***the voter***~~[he]~~ shall sign his ***or her*** name on the precinct
8 list in the space opposite ***the voter's***~~[his]~~ printed name, ***or electronically if***
9 ***provided***. The voter's signature shall constitute ***the voter's***~~[his]~~ verification that he
10 ***or she*** is a properly registered and qualified voter. The voter shall then retire alone
11 to cast his ***or her*** vote on the voting machine ***or the provided ballot***. The county
12 board of elections may provide to each precinct the original registration form of
13 each voter entitled to vote in that precinct. These forms shall be used to compare
14 signatures in those precincts to which the forms are provided.
- 15 (2) If supplemental paper ballots are used~~[,]~~ as provided in KRS 118.215, after voting
16 on the voting machine ***or on the regular paper ballot***, the voter shall take the
17 supplemental paper ballot with the stub intact and retire alone to the voting booth
18 provided for voting ***supplemental*** paper ballots. After voting the supplemental
19 paper ballot, the voter shall remove the numbered stub, hand the stub to an election
20 official, and deposit the voted ***supplemental paper*** ballot in the locked
21 ***supplemental paper*** ballot box.
