Mr. YOUNG of Alaska introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To improve the Department of Housing and Urban
Development's regulations on hazardous storage containers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMPROVING HUD HAZARDOUS STORAGE CON-**
4 **TAINER REGULATIONS.**

5 The Secretary of Housing and Urban Development
6 shall prescribe, or amend existing, regulations to include
7 as an exception from the definition of the term “hazard”,
8 as defined under subpart C of part 51 of title 24, Code
9 of Federal Regulations, any stationary container which

1 stores, handles, or processes hazardous substances of an
2 explosive or fire-prone nature that—

3 (1) has a capacity of 1,320 gallons or less;

4 (2) is intended to contain common liquid fuels
5 such as gasoline, fuel oil, kerosene, diesel, or crude
6 oil;

7 (3) is sited on land or property that contains a
8 one- to four-family dwelling;

9 (4) is intended to be used solely by residents of
10 such dwelling; and

11 (5) is intended to be used by residents of such
12 dwelling exclusively for non-commercial, non-indus-
13 trial purposes.
