HOUSE BILL 485

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-199, relative to traffic safety.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. This act is known and may be cited as the "Eddie Conrad Act."
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-199(c), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision (4):
 - (A) A second or subsequent violation of this section by a person who is younger than eighteen (18) years of age results in seven (7) points being charged to the person's driving record.
 - (B) If a person is eighteen (18) years of age or older, then:
 - (i) A first or second violation of this section results in four (4) points being charged to the person's driving record; and
 - (ii) A third or subsequent violation of this section results in five (5) points being charged to the person's driving record.
 - SECTION 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2023, the public welfare requiring it.
