A BILL

To amend the Afghan Allies Protection Act of 2009 to make 2,500 visas available for the Afghan Special Immigrant Visa program, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keeping Our Promise
5 to Our Afghan Allies Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SPECIAL IMMIGRANT VISAS FOR AFGHAN ALLIES.**

2 Section 602(b)(3)(F) of Afghan Allies Protection Act
3 of 2009 (8 U.S.C. 1101 note) is amended in the matter
4 preceding clause (i), by striking “8,500” and inserting
5 “11,000”.

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
