SENATE BILL 1342

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to controlled dangerous substances;
prohibiting drug wholesaler from preventing certain
purchase of drugs by licensed pharmacy; defining
term; directing promulgation of rules; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-311.1 of Title 63, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A drug wholesaler is prohibited from preventing a licensed
pharmacy under contract with the wholesaler from purchasing drugs
that the wholesaler sells if the pharmacy is in compliance with all
applicable state and federal laws.

B. As used in this section, "drug wholesaler" means any person
within this state, other than a manufacturer, who sells, transfers,
or in any manner furnishes a drug product to any other person in
this state for the purpose of being resold.

1 C. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and
2 Dangerous Drugs Control shall promulgate rules to implement the
3 provisions of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
