A BILL

To extend the Vietnam Service Medal to veterans of the Armed Forces who participated in the S.S. Mayaguez rescue operation.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Recognizing Mayaguez

5 Veterans Act".

6 SEC. 2. AWARD OF VIETNAM SERVICE MEDAL TO VETERANS 7 WHO PARTICIPATED IN MAYAGUEZ RESCUE 8 OPERATION.

9 (a) AWARD AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of the10 military department concerned shall, upon the application

by or on behalf of an individual who is an eligible veteran,
 award that individual the Vietnam Service Medal, notwith standing any otherwise applicable requirements for the
 award of that medal. Any such award shall be made in
 lieu of any Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal awarded
 the individual for the individual's participation in the Ma yaguez rescue operation.

8 (b) TREATMENT OF DECEASED VETERANS.—In the 9 case of a veteran who is deceased, the application de-10 scribed in subsection (a) may be submitted by the next 11 of kin of the veteran.

(c) ELIGIBLE VETERAN.—For purposes of this section, the term "eligible veteran" means a veteran of the
Armed Forces—

(1) who was awarded the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal for participation in military operations known as the Mayaguez rescue operation of
May 12–15, 1975; or

19 (2) who participated in such operation.
