A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to defer the deployment of a member of the Armed Forces who gives birth for one year unless the member elects to deploy with the approval of a health care provider employed at a military medical facility.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Equal Deferment Op-
- 5 portunity Act".

SEC. 2. DEFERRED DEPLOYMENT FOR MEMBERS OF THE 2 ARMED FORCES WHO GIVE BIRTH. 3 Section 701 of title 10, United States Code, is 4 amended by adding at the end the following new subsection: 5 "(l) A member of the armed forces who gives birth 6 may not be deployed during the period of 12 months be-7 ginning on the date of such birth except— 8 "(1) at the election of such member; and 9 "(2) with the approval of a health care provider 10 11 employed at a military medical treatment facility.".
