FOR the purpose of authorizing a student who is enrolled at a public high school to satisfy
a certain graduation requirement to earn credits in mathematics by completing a
credit in computer science or computer programming under certain circumstances;
requiring a county board of education to make a certain certification that a certain
course may count toward a certain graduation requirement; and generally relating
to a requirement for mathematics credits at public high schools.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article Education
- 18 **7–209.**

(A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A STUDENT ENROLLED AT A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL MAY SATISFY ONE CREDIT OF A REQUIREMENT TO EARN THREE CREDITS IN MATHEMATICS BY COMPLETING A CREDIT IN A COMPUTER SCIENCE OR COMPUTER PROGRAMMING COURSE SELECTED BY THE COUNTY BOARD.



1 (B) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL CERTIFY TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT THE 2 COURSE MAY COUNT TOWARD THE MATHEMATICS GRADUATION REQUIREMENT.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4 1, 2020.
