AN ACT

To repeal section 620.2459, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to grants to expand access to broadband internet service in unserved and underserved areas of the state.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 620.2459, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 620.2459, to read as follows:

620.2459. Pursuant to section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:

(1) The provisions of the [new] program authorized under sections 620.2450, 620.2451, 620.2452, 620.2453, 620.2454, 620.2455, 620.2456, 620.2457, and 620.2458 shall sunset [automatically three years after August 28, 2018] on **August 28, 2027**, unless reauthorized by an act of the general assembly; and

(2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under sections 620.2450, 620.2451, 620.2452, 620.2453, 620.2454, 620.2455, 620.2456, 620.2457, and 620.2458 shall sunset automatically six years after the effective date of the reauthorization of sections 620.2450, 620.2451, 620.2452, 620.2453, 620.2454, 620.2455, 620.2456, 620.2457, and 620.2458; and

(3) Sections 620.2450, 620.2451, 620.2452, 620.2453, 620.2454, 620.2455, 620.2456, 620.2457, and 620.2458 shall terminate on September first of the calendar year immediately following the calendar year in which the program authorized under sections 620.2450, 620.2451, 620.2452, 620.2453, 620.2454, 620.2455, 620.2456, 620.2457, and 620.2458 is sunset.
