## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 13, 2017, as National Guard Day at the capitol; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Defense provides ready and relevant military forces
- 4 to the Combatant Commanders and, with the consent of the Governor, provides command
- 5 and control capabilities to support homeland defense and defense support to civil authorities;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Defense is located at the Clay National Guard
- 8 Center in Marietta, Georgia, and includes the Georgia Army National Guard, the Georgia Air
- 9 National Guard, and the Georgia State Defense Force; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Defense employs over 10,908 Army National Guard
- 11 Soldiers, 2,896 Air National Guard Airmen, 509 State Defense Force members, and 632 state
- 12 employees; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Georgia's Army National Guard is the eighth largest in the nation composed of
- 14 combat, combat support, and combat service support units training in nearly 70 hometown
- 15 armories and regional facilities across the state; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Georgia's Army National Guard is organized into five major subordinate
- 17 commands which are the Macon-based 48th Infantry Brigade Combat Team, the 78th Troop
- 18 Command, the 78th Aviation Troop Command, the 201st Regional Support Group at Clay
- 19 National Guard Center in Marietta, and the 648th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade at Fort
- 20 Benning in Columbus; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the Georgia Air National Guard is the air power component of the State of
- 22 Georgia with 2,896 airmen and officers assigned to the 116th Air Control Wing in Warner
- 23 Robins, the 165th Airlift Wing in Savannah, and seven geographically separated units H. R. 173

24 throughout Georgia; and they play an active role in supporting Georgia's homeland defense

- 25 posture, providing airlift, engineering, and communications resources and abilities; and
- 26 WHEREAS, the Georgia State Defense Force is a volunteer unit of the Georgia Department
- of Defense, serving in support of the national and state constitutions under the direction of
- 28 the Governor and the adjutant general of Georgia; and
- 29 WHEREAS, in 2016 alone, the Georgia National Guard deployed more than 600 soldiers and
- 30 airmen to every geographic command; and
- 31 WHEREAS, the Georgia National Guard also operated one of the most robust and successful
- 32 Youth Challenge Academy programs in the United States at Fort Stewart and Fort Gordon,
- 33 Georgia, where to date over 14,000 high school dropouts have graduated and have been
- 34 given opportunities to receive a high school diploma or general educational development
- 35 (GED) diploma; in addition, Georgia's Youth Challenge Academy has been instrumental in
- 36 helping these young men and women secure a lasting future through assistance in
- 37 employment opportunities for the recent graduates; and
- 38 WHEREAS, following more than two decades of partnership between Argentina and the
- 39 State of Georgia, the National Guard Bureau selected the Georgia Department of Defense to
- 40 serve as a state partner to Argentina; and
- 41 WHEREAS, the selfless and heroic actions of the Georgia National Guard stand as a shining
- 42 tribute to the strength of the human spirit, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the
- 43 outstanding accomplishments of these remarkable and distinguished Georgians be
- 44 appropriately recognized.
- 45 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 46 the members of this body commend the men and women of the Georgia National Guard for
- 47 their strength, leadership, and courage in their willingness to find meaning in something
- 48 greater than themselves and recognize February 13, 2017, as National Guard Day at the
- 49 capitol.
- 50 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 52 Georgia National Guard.
