5 (a) (1) The Office of Minority Health and Health Disparities shall provide to 6 each board a list of recommended courses in cultural and linguistic competency, health 7 disparities, and health literacy.

8 (2) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT 9 OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, SHALL PROVIDE TO EACH BOARD A LIST OF RECOMMENDED 10 COURSES IN MILITARY CULTURE.

11 (b) Each board shall:

12 (1) Post the list of recommended courses provided to the board under 13 subsection (a) of this section prominently on the board's Web site;

14 (2) Provide information about the recommended courses to health care 15 professionals at the time of renewal of licensure; and

16 (3) Advertise the availability of the recommended courses in newsletters 17 and any other media published by the board.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2017.
