Mr. DAINES (for himself and Mr. TESTER) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To designate a mountain ridge in the State of Montana
as “B–47 Ridge”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “B–47 Ridge Designa-
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF B–47 RIDGE, MONTANA.**

7 (a) DESIGNATION.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—The unnamed mountain
9 ridge located at 45°14′40.89″N, 110°43′38.75″W
10 that runs south and west of Emigrant Peak in the

1 Absaroka Range in the State of Montana, which is
2 the approximate site of a crash of a B-47, shall be
3 known and designated as “B-47 Ridge”.

4 (2) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law,
5 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of
6 the United States to the ridge described in para-
7 graph (1) shall be deemed to be a reference to “B-
8 47 Ridge”.

9 (b) AUTHORIZATION FOR PLAQUE.—

10 (1) IN GENERAL.—A plaque that memorializes
11 the crash of the B-47 (including denoting the names
12 of the victims of the crash) may be installed on B-
13 47 Ridge.

14 (2) FUNDING.—No Federal funds may be used
15 to design, procure, install, or maintain the plaque
16 authorized under paragraph (1).
