#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program – Exemptions – Vehicles With Low Annual Mileage

- 4 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that, in order for a vehicle that is driven less  $\mathbf{5}$ than a certain number of miles over a certain period of time to be exempt from 6 mandatory inspection and testing requirements, the owner of the vehicle must meet 7 certain disability or age requirements; decreasing the maximum number of miles a 8 motor vehicle may be driven annually in order to be exempt from mandatory 9 inspection and testing requirements; exempting certain vehicles from certain inspection and testing requirements under certain circumstances; and generally 10 11 relating to the exemption of certain vehicles from mandatory inspection and testing 12requirements of the vehicle emissions inspection program.
