 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Licensing Access
 - 5 for Governments Act of 2019" or the "FLAG Act of
 - 6 2019".

1	SECTION 2. REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN MARKS CON-
2	SISTING OF FLAGS, COATS OF ARMS, OR
3	OTHER INSIGNIA.
4	Section 2(b) of the Act entitled "An Act to provide
5	for the registration and protection of trademarks used in
6	commerce, to carry out the provisions of certain inter-
7	national conventions, and for other purposes", approved
8	July 5, 1946 (commonly referred to as the "Trademark
9	Act of 1946"; 15 U.S.C. 1052(b)) is amended by inserting
10	"except by the written consent of the competent author-
11	ity" after "simulation thereof".
