## Education - Public School Athletics - Basketball Schedule

FOR the purpose of establishing rules for public school athletic schedules for basketball; prohibiting a team, except under certain circumstances, from playing more than a certain number of games per week; providing that the basketball schedule consists of a certain number of regular season games for a team that elects to play in a tournament or showcase game and a certain number of regular season games for other teams; authorizing a team, in addition to certain regular season games, to play in up to a certain number of tournament games or a number of showcase games determined by the county board in a year; providing that a tournament may be scheduled outside the normal basketball season; authorizing a State team to play in a tournament or showcase game against certain out-of-state teams under certain circumstances; requiring each county board of education to decide whether to authorize a team to play in a tournament or showcase game; authorizing the county board to authorize a team to play in an already scheduled tournament or showcase game or a tournament or showcase game scheduled by the county board; and generally relating to the basketball schedule for public schools.

[^0]SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - Education

7-125.
(A) ALL PUBLIC SCHOOL ATHLETIC SCHEDULES FOR BASKETBALL SHALL COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION.
(B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A BASKETBALL TEAM MAY NOT PLAY MORE THAN TWO GAMES PER WEEK.
(2) A team may elect to play three games per week twice DURING THE BASKETBALL SEASON.
(C) THE BASKETBALL SEASON SHALL CONSIST OF:
(1) 20 REGULAR SEASON GAMES FOR A TEAM THAT ELECTS TO PLAY IN A TOURNAMENT; AND
(2) 22 REGULAR SEASON GAMES FOR A TEAM THAT DOES NOT ELECT TO PLAY IN A TOURNAMENT.
(D) (1) (I) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IN ADDITION TO THE REGULAR SEASON GAMES AUTHORIZED UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION, EACH YEAR A TEAM MAY PLAY IN UP TO FOUR TOURNAMENT GAMES AND A NUMBER OF SHOWCASE GAMES DETERMINED bY THE COUNTY BOARD, INCLUDING DURING A NCAA Evaluation PERIOD.
(II) A TOURNAMENT OR SHOWCASE MAY BE SCHEDULED OUTSIDE THE NORMAL BASKETBALL SEASON.
(III) A STATE TEAM MAY PLAY IN A TOURNAMENT OR SHOWCASE GAME AGAINST A TEAM FROM OUTSIDE THE STATE IF THE OUT-OF-STATE TEAM HAS EQUIVALENT QUALIFICATIONS TO THOSE REQUIRED OF THE STATE TEAM.
(2) (I) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DECIDE WHETHER TO AUTHORIZE A TEAM TO PLAY IN A TOURNAMENT.
(II) A COUNTY BOARD MAY AUTHORIZE A TEAM TO:

1. PLAY IN AN ALREADY SCHEDULED TOURNAMENT; OR

2 BOARD. BOARD. 1, 2020.

## 2. PLAY IN A TOURNAMENT SCHEDULED BY THE COUNTY

(3) (I) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DECIDE WHETHER TO AUTHORIZE A TEAM TO PLAY IN SHOWCASE GAMES.
(II) A COUNTY BOARD MAY AUTHORIZE A TEAM TO:

1. PLAY IN AN ALREADY SCHEDULED SHOWCASE GAME OR SERIES OF GAMES; OR
2. PLAY IN SHOWCASE GAMES SCHEDULED BY A COUNTY
(III) A COUNTY BOARD MAY AUTHORIZE TEAMS TO PLAY IN ANY NUMBER OF SHOWCASE GAMES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
