A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to ensure that on-duty time does not include waiting time at a natural gas or oil well site for certain commercial motor vehicle operators, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preserving Jobs in the
- 5 Oilfield Act of 2017".

1 SEC. 2. WAITING TIME EXCEPTION.

- 2 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Transportation
- 3 shall ensure that the exception described in section
- 4 395.1(d)(2) of title 49, Code of Federal Regulations (re-
- 5 lating to on-duty time not including waiting time at a nat-
- 6 ural gas or oil well site) applies to covered operators, ex-
- 7 cept that the exception shall apply to such operators with-
- 8 out regard to whether such operators have received special
- 9 training or operate vehicles specially constructed to service
- 10 wells.
- 11 (b) COVERED OPERATOR DEFINED.—In this section,
- 12 the term "covered operator" means the operator of a com-
- 13 mercial motor vehicle transporting supplies, equipment, or
- 14 materials, including sand or water, to or from a natural
- 15 gas or oil well site.
