A RESOLUTION to honor and congratulate Dr. Terry Stevens

through the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program; he was appointed by Governor Bill Haslam

in January 2018 to the Governor's Opioid Abuse Task Force for the Tennessee Commission on Pain and Addiction Medicine Education; and
