AN ACT

- To authorize the Women Who Worked on the Home Front Foundation to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Women Who Worked3 on the Home Front World War II Memorial Act".

4 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH COMMEMORATIVE 5 WORK.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Women Who Worked on the 7 Home Front Foundation may establish a commemorative 8 work on Federal land in the District of Columbia and its 9 environs to commemorate the commitment and service 10 represented by women who worked on the home front dur-11 ing World War II.

(b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMORATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the commemorative work under this section shall be in accordance with
chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly
known as the "Commemorative Works Act").

17 (c) PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL18 FUNDS.—

19 (1) IN GENERAL.—Federal funds may not be
20 used to pay any expense of the establishment of the
21 commemorative work under this section.

(2) RESPONSIBILITY OF WOMEN WHO WORKED
ON THE HOME FRONT FOUNDATION.—The Women
Who Worked on the Home Front Foundation shall
be solely responsible for acceptance of contributions

for, and payment of the expenses of, the establish ment of the commemorative work under this section.
 (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—If upon payment of all ex-4 5 penses for the establishment of the memorial (in-6 cluding the maintenance and preservation amount 7 required by section 8906(b)(1) of title 40. United 8 States Code), there remains a balance of funds re-9 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative 10 work, the Women Who Worked on the Home Front 11 Foundation shall transmit the amount of the balance 12 to the Secretary of the Interior for deposit in the ac-13 count provided for in section 8906(b)(3) of title 40, 14 United States Code.

15 (2) ON EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY.—If upon 16 expiration of the authority for the commemorative 17 work under section 8903(e) of title 40, United 18 States Code, there remains a balance of funds re-19 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative 20 work, the Women Who Worked on the Home Front 21 Foundation shall transmit the amount of the balance 22 to a separate account with the National Park Foun-23 dation for memorials, to be available to the Sec-24 retary of the Interior or Administrator (as appro-25 priate) following the process provided in section

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1	8906(b)(4) of title 40, United States Code, for ac-
2	counts established under section $8906(b)(2)$ or (3)
3	of title 40, United States Code.

4 SEC. 3. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

5 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, 6 7 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this 8 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record 9 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-10 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the 11 vote on passage. 12
