## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring William "Willie" H. Mays III; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Willie Mays III is the beloved son of the late William H. Mays II and Carrie J.  
3 Mays, the first woman to serve on the Augusta City Council; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a graduate of T.W. Josey High School, Mr. Mays attended Gupton-Jones  
5 College of Mortuary Science and Augusta College; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Willie is a third generation mortician and the owner of the W.H. Mays  
7 Mortuary; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he has served as the youngest president and chairman of the board of the State  
9 Funeral Directors Association, a board member of the National Funeral Directors and  
10 Morticians Association, the Eighth District chairman of GFSPA, and a member of Epsilon  
11 Nu Delta Mortuary Fraternity; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in 1979, Willie became the second youngest person ever elected to serve on the  
13 Augusta City Council at the age of 28, a position to which he was reelected on two  
14 consecutive occasions; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was elected to the Richmond County Board of Commissioners in 1990 and  
16 commissioner at large of one of the two at-large super districts in the consolidated  
17 government of Augusta-Richmond County, served three terms as mayor pro tem for the  
18 Augusta-Richmond County Board of Commissioners, and was elected to serve as interim  
19 mayor for the City of Augusta in 2005; and
- 20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
21 Georgian be recognized appropriately.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
23 the members of this body honor William H. Mays III for his contributions to his community  
24 and the State of Georgia.
