## SEC. 2. FAILURE TO COMPLETE CERTAIN BUDGETARY AC TIONS BY A DATE CERTAIN.

3 Section 303 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974
4 (2 U.S.C. 634) is amended by adding at the end the fol5 lowing new subsection:

6 "(d) FAILURE TO ADOPT CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 7 ON THE BUDGET BY A DATE CERTAIN.—(1) If by April 8 15 of each calendar year, the House of Representatives 9 and the Senate have not adopted a concurrent resolution 10 on the budget as required by section 301(a) of the Con-11 gressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974, 12 beginning on the next calendar day, and on every other 13 calendar day thereafter until adoption of a concurrent resolution on the budget, Members shall record their presence 14 by electronic device for purposes of establishing a quorum. 15 In the House of Representatives, during the period de-16 17 scribed in this subsection, a motion to adjourn to a day 18 and time certain offered pursuant to clause 4(c)(1)(B) of 19 rule XVI of the Rules of the House of Representatives 20may not require the House to stand adjourned for more 21 than one calendar day.

22 "(2) For the purposes of this subsection, a 'calendar
23 day' shall exclude Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holi24 days.".

7 (b) PASSAGE OF GENERAL APPROPRIATION BILLS.—
8 Section 309 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 (2
9 U.S.C. 640) (as amended by subsection (a)) is further
10 amended by adding at the end the following new sub11 section:

"(b) 12 PASSAGE GENERAL APPROPRIATION OF 13 BILLS.—(1) If by the last day of each fiscal year, the House of Representatives and the Senate have not passed 14 each of the general appropriation bills, individually or a 15 16 combination thereof, beginning on the next calendar day, 17 and on every other calendar day thereafter until the pas-18 sage of all general appropriation bills, individually or a 19 combination thereof, Members shall record their presence by electronic device for purposes of establishing a quorum. 20 In the House of Representatives, during the period de-21 22 scribed in this subsection, a motion to adjourn to a day 23 and time certain offered pursuant to clause 4(c)(1)(B) of 24 rule XVI may not require the House to stand adjourned for more than one calendar day. 25

"(2) For the purposes of this subsection, a 'calendar
 day' shall exclude Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holi days.".
