1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4013** is enacted to read:

3 **§4013. Lunch period**

4 A school administrative unit shall provide for all students under the jurisdiction of the
5 school administrative unit a lunch period of at least 30 minutes unless the governing body
6 of the school administrative unit determines by vote after notice and public hearing that a
7 30-minute lunch period would be impracticable.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill requires that school administrative units provide for students a lunch period
10 of at least 30 minutes unless the governing body of the school administrative unit
11 determines by vote after notice and public hearing that a 30-minute lunch period would
12 be impracticable.
