- 8 gress pursuant to section 36(b) of the Arms Export
- 9 Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)) and published in

the Congressional Record on June 4, 2019: The proposed sale of a blanket-order United States Marine Corps training, training support, and other training related services in support of the United Arab Emirates Presidential Guard Command.
