To reauthorize the Helen Keller National Center for Youths and Adults Who Are Deaf-Blind.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Helen Keller National
- 5 Center Reauthorization Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. HELEN KELLER NATIONAL CENTER REAUTHOR-
- 7 **IZED.**
- 8 The first sentence of section 205(a) of the Helen Kel-
- 9 ler National Center Act (29 U.S.C. 1904(a)) is amended

- 1 by striking "1999 through 2003" and inserting "2019
- 2 through 2023".
