## A BILL

To improve the pediatric mental health care access grant program.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Supporting Children's

5 Mental Health Care Access Act of 2022".

6 SEC. 2. PEDIATRIC MENTAL HEALTH CARE ACCESS

7 GRANTS.

8 Section 330M of the Public Health Service Act (42

9 U.S.C. 254c–19) is amended—

10 (1) in subsection (b)—

1 (A) in paragraph (1)— 2 (i) in subparagraph (G)— 3 (I) by inserting "developmentalbehavioral pediatricians," after "ado-4 5 lescent psychiatrists,"; and (II) by inserting ", and which 6 7 may include addiction specialists," after "mental health counselors"; 8 9 (ii) in subparagraph (H), by striking "; and" and inserting a semicolon; 10 11 (iii) in subparagraph (I), by striking the period and inserting "; and"; and 12 13 (iv) by adding at the end the fol-14 lowing: "(J) maintain an up-to-date list of commu-15 16 nity-based supports for children with mental 17 health problems."; 18 (B) in paragraph (2), by inserting ", and 19 which may include a developmental-behavioral 20 pediatrician and an addiction specialist" before 21 the period at the end of the first sentence; and 22 (C) by adding at the end the following: "(3) Support to schools and emergency 23 24 DEPARTMENTS.—In addition to the required activi-25 ties specified in paragraph (1), a statewide or regional network of pediatric mental health teams re ferred to in subsection (a), with respect to which a
 grant under such subsection may be used, may pro vide support to schools and emergency depart ments.";

6 (2) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub7 section (h);

8 (3) by inserting after subsection (f) the fol-9 lowing:

10 "(g) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary may 11 award a grant to an eligible entity for purposes of pro-12 viding technical assistance to recipients of grants under 13 subsection (a)."; and

(4) in subsection (h), as so redesignated, by
striking "\$9,000,000 for the period of fiscal years
2018 through 2022" and inserting "such sums as
may be necessary for the period of fiscal years 2023
through 2027".

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
