## A BILL

To reauthorize the program to support residential treatment programs for pregnant and postpartum women, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pregnant and  
5 Postpartum Women Treatment Reauthorization Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF PROGRAM.**

7 Section 508 of the Public Health Service Act (42  
8 U.S.C. 290bb–1) is amended—

1           (1) in subsection (d)(11)(C), by striking “pro-  
2           viding health services” and inserting “providing  
3           health care services”;

4           (2) in subsection (g)—

5                 (A) by inserting “a plan describing” after  
6                 “will provide”; and

7                 (B) by adding at the end the following:  
8                 “Such plan may include a description of how  
9                 such applicant will target outreach to women  
10                disproportionately impacted by maternal sub-  
11                stance use disorder.”; and

12           (3) in subsection (s), by striking “\$29,931,000  
13           for each of fiscal years 2019 through 2023” and in-  
14           serting “\$38,931,000 for each of fiscal years 2024  
15           through 2028”.
