- 18 Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, if an officer of a 19 humane society sees a person committing a misdemeanor that involves cruelty to an 20 animal, the officer shall arrest and bring before the District Court the person committing 21 the misdemeanor.
- 22 In Calvert County, if an officer of a humane society or an animal control officer 23 appointed by the County Commissioners or the County Commissioners' designee sees a 24person committing a misdemeanor that involves cruelty to an animal, the officer shall arrest and bring before the District Court the person committing the misdemeanor.



- 1 (c) In Baltimore County, the Baltimore County Department of Health, Division 2 of Animal Control shall enforce this section.
- 3 (D) (1) WITHIN THE FIRST 12 MONTHS OF EMPLOYMENT, AN OFFICER OF

- 8 (2) AN OFFICER OF A HUMANE SOCIETY OR AN ANIMAL CONTROL

  10 EDUCATION APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE UNIT OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL
